## Preparing for 2019: Drug policy objectives and indicators, system-wide coherence and the Sustainable Development Agenda

Recent years have seen increasing discussion devoted to the issue drug policy objectives and indicators, including, since 2015, their relationship to the Sustainable Development Agenda and the associated SDGs. While some attention was given to both issues in the UNGASS Outcome Document, the approach of the High-Level session in 2019 necessitates more detailed consideration of what is becoming an ever-more pressing topic of concern. This side event aims to explore several inter-related themes:

1. mindful of the expiration of the targets set in the 2009 Political Declaration, assess the need for and possible form of revised drug policy targets
2. examine the intersection between drug policy metrics and SDG targets and discuss the problems associated with bringing these together in a post-2019 set of indicators
3. explore how a broader set of drug policy targets and indicators might improve system-wide coherence and better integrate other competent UN agencies
4. considering the Outcome Document recommendations on issues such as human rights, discuss any necessary revision of the Annual Report Questionnaire.
